Rental Information and Rules 2008-2009

Entering the Club

- Enter through the main front door of the club.
- All street shoes must be cleaned at the door using the shoe cleaner.
- The coed change room is on the left.
- Do not leave valuables in the change room as the club is not responsible for personal items.
- Proceed to ice area by the south door of locker room (leads directly to ice area). Return to the change rooms through the same door.
- The Members Lounge (at top of stairs) is accessible by the stairs or elevator.

Equipment

- Brooms and Sliders are available for use. Brooms are kept behind marked door to left after entering ice surface. Sliders are kept on ice level walkway.
- We request that Brooms be cleaned and returned to the storage room.

On Ice Rules:

- No street shoes allowed on the ice, only curling shoes or clean, dry, soft/rubber soled shoes are allowed on the ice surface.
- Sliders are to be used for delivery only and **not** to be used when sweeping.
- All shoes should be cleaned before entering onto the ice.
- All brooms to be cleaned before using them on the ice.
- No lifting of rocks off the ice.
- No food or beverages allowed at the ice level.
- In order to allow for proper ice maintenance allocated rental times **must** be strictly respected.

In case of an accident: KEEP CALM

- A First Aid Kit is available on the ice surface by the co-ed change room door.
- For properly trained individuals a Defibrillator Unit is available in main hallway between the elevator door and the co-ed change room door.
- Phone is located on the north wall immediately to the right of the entrance, when looking back from the ice surface, call 911 if necessary.
- Fire alarm pulls are located at all exterior exit doors on the main level and one beside each door in the lounge.
- Fire extinguishers are located:
 - In each change room;
 - In the kitchen upstairs;
 - In the lounge beside the east exit door.
- In the event of an alarm sounding, you must leave the facility immediately through the closest exit.
